
## NE 15<sup>th</sup> St Bike Lanes (NE 16<sup>th</sup> Ave to NE 39<sup>th</sup> Ave)

CITY COMMISSION DISTRICT I

The NE 15<sup>th</sup> Street is a collector road that carries up to 5,000 average trips per day and serves eleven RTS transit bus stops, traversing a primarily low-density residential area. The project extent covered approximately 1.5 miles. Safety was a concern given the high travel speeds and crash incidence. The project implemented buffered bike lanes within the curb space to close a gap in the cycling network; the narrowing of the travel lanes also contributed to decrease travel speeds. The project ties to the City's Strategic Plan Goal 3: A Great Place to Live and Experience by promoting safety and accessibility to a diverse population. Future phases include upgrades to bus stops, ADA facilities and pedestrian crossings. The project was funded with a recurring capital allocation for bicycle and pedestrian improvements.
