NW 73rd Ave Multi-Use Trail (NW 43rd St to Existing)



The project added a 10 ft wide paved multi-use trail to accommodate bicyclists and pedestrians while avoiding impacts to wetlands, improving stormwater management conditions, and adding a mid-block marked pedestrian crossing along NW 73rd Ave. The trail closed a gap in the sidewalk network by providing access from the Blues Creek and Weschester neighborhoods to NW 43rd St and connecting to the existing trail system in San Felasco Park, providing a recreational opportunity for nearby residents as well as visitors to the park. The project ties to the City's Strategic *Plan Goal 3: A Great Place to Live and Experience* by promoting safety and accessibility to a diverse population.
