

# SW 37<sup>th</sup> Blvd Reconstruction

## CITY COMMISSION DISTRICT III

The project involved the partial reconstruction of approximately 600 ft of roadway adding new turn lanes, extending the existing southbound left turn queue length at the intersection of Archer Rd, adding a sidewalk along the east side of the road closing a gap in the network, and upgrading curb ramps to current accessibility standards. This project was partially funded with TMPA<sup>1</sup> funds via a public-private partnership between the City and a developer (Legislative Item #200120) enabling faster deployment of a needed congestion relief and safety improvement, while reducing overall costs by consolidating resources and minimizing overall disruptions to travelers. The project ties to the City's Strategic Plan Goal 3: *A Great Place to Live and Experience* by promoting safety and accessibility to a diverse population.


