NOTICE: Any protest or challenge based on the belief that any ballot is illegal due to any defect apparent on the Voter's Certificate must be filed with the Board of Canvassers before the ballot is removed from the mailing envelope, and shall not be accepted after the ballot has been removed from the mailing envelope. If any person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board at these meetings, they will need a record of the proceedings, and they need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made. **This notice applies to all meetings.**

BALLOT TABULATION: Results will not be tabulated for vote-by-mail ballots or early voting ballots until after the polls close on Election Day.

Each candidate, political party official, political committee official, or an authorized designee thereof, shall be granted reasonable access upon request to review or inspect ballot materials before canvassing or tabulation. You must call the Elections Office at (352) 374-5252 and request access at least 24 hours prior to such access being granted. An attestation must be completed before access is granted. Authorized designees must provide a signed letter from the candidate or entity designating them as a representative. October 22 – Wednesday – 10:00 a.m. – The Board of Canvassers will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to test and seal the vote tabulation equipment to be used in all phases of the Gainesville Special Referendum Election.

October 30 – Thursday – 10:00 a.m. – The Board of Canvassers will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to review criteria used to accept vote-by-mail ballots, inspect, approve, open, and scan the vote-by-mail ballots, which have been received by the Supervisor of Elections. Ballot duplication may occur. Sealed ballots will be available for public inspection at 9:30 AM.

November 3 – Monday – 2:00 PM (if needed) – The Board of Canvassers will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to review and process additional vote-by-mail ballots received by the Supervisor of Elections. Ballot duplication may occur. Sealed ballots will be available for public inspection at 1:30 PM.

November 4 – Tuesday – 4:00 PM – The Board of Canvassers will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to review and process additional vote-by-mail ballots received by the Supervisor of Elections. Ballot duplication may occur. Sealed ballots will be available for public inspection at 3:30 PM.

November 4 – Tuesday – 6:00 PM – The Board of Canvassers will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to continue to review and process additional vote-by-mail ballots, to canvass the returns from early voting and the precincts after 7:00 p.m. Ballot duplication may occur. Sealed ballots will be available for inspection at 5:30 p.m., if available. The Board will release the Unofficial Results.

November 6 – Thursday – 4:30 PM – The Board of Canvassers will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to review and process additional vote-by-mail ballots, review cured signature mismatches, cured missing signatures, and ballots with non-curable errors. After 5:01 p.m., the Boad will review mismatched signatures and provisional ballots along with any evidence provided, and certify the Official Results. Ballot duplication may also occur. Sealed ballots will be available for inspection at 4:00 p.m., if available. The Board will then review the audit selection process and make selections for the post-election audit of the voting system.

November 12 – Wednesday – 10:00 AM –The Board of Canvassers will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to review the audit process and conduct the post-election audit of the voting system per Florida Statutes.
