If you already have an **existing concrete or paved driveway** and you do not want to add any additional pullout spaces, please check the box in the top section of the form marked "Existing Concrete or Paved Driveway Only – No Pullout spaces requested." If you want to **include pullout spaces**, then refer to the following instructions:

Measurements:

Measure the front lot dimensions using the formula in the EXAMPLE Driveway Parking Plan. Document this information on the reverse side (bottom section) of this paper. (Measure the width and depth of the lot according to the example.)

Drawing:

Draw a sketch of the house. The plan does <u>not</u> have to be drawn to scale. (See example.)

Draw any porches or carports. (See example.)

Draw the existing driveway. (See example.)

Draw where you intend to build the pullout spaces.

- Remember, only one (1) pullout space is permitted with an **existing circular driveway**; no more than two (2) pullout spaces are permitted for non-circular driveways.
- The width of any one (1) pullout space shall not exceed 9 feet. (Two (2) pullout spaces can be combined as long as the width does not exceed 18 feet.)
- The maximum **length** shall not exceed 16 feet. (Two (2) pullout spaces <u>cannot</u> be combined lengthwise.)
- Pullout spaces shall be parallel, perpendicular, or angular to and contiguous with the primary driveway parking area.

Fill in all of the fields:

- Check off the type of <u>erosion preventing material</u> you plan to use for your driveway or pullout space(s). If you intend to use something other than what is listed, check "**other**" and document the material you have selected. Any erosion preventing material listed as an "**other**" will be pending approval based on the material's erosion preventing qualities and the Code Enforcement Officer's ability to easily distinguish it from other areas of the yard.
- Check off the type of <u>border material</u> you plan to use for your driveway or pullout space(s). If you have chosen something that is not listed, check "other" and document the material you plan to use. Any border material listed as an "other" will be pending approval based on the material's ability to prevent loss of the erosion preventing material and to minimize the movement of the border by a car or person.
 - All Borders are required to be staked down and incapable of moving. Temporary or movable borders are prohibited.
