The Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) Program is committed to excellence and service through the administration of Suboxone and support.

The program works with willing individuals anonymously to treat addiction and withdrawal symptoms with **Suboxone and assistive medications**. The program is on a custom, mobile plan that works with the patients daily dose needs.
