**What to Bring:** Birth certificate, proof of residency\*, free lunch certificate (if applying for the scholarship\*\*), and completed registration form.

\*\*A \$15 scholarship will be offered to those who have been approved through the school board to receive free/reduced lunch. You may also apply for this scholarship through our PRCA office at the time of registration. Please provide one of the following at registration: a certificate from SBAC, your SNAP/TANF number or pay stubs from the most recent 4 weeks, at the time of registration.
