Hoyt spent years as a lively and humorous Earth Academy Day Camp (EADC) camper exploring Morningside and learning about the natural area around us. He became an EADC volunteer Junior Naturalist to help younger kids get the most out of their camp experience. This scholarship continues Hoyt's mission of connecting the next generation of campers to the world we share.

The Friends of Nature Parks (FoNP) is proud to support Earth Academy Day Camp programs by offering scholarships that cover 100% of registration fees to successful applicants.

- Scholarships are based on eligibility and availability. They must be applied for in advance.
- Registration for all camp sessions is *first come, first served* and scholarship recipients are not guaranteed a spot in any camp session.
- The City of Gainesville does not administer scholarship monies nor take responsibility for the selection of scholarship recipients. Friends of Nature Parks provides the scholarship funding for approved recipients.

To apply, register and participate:

1) Submit a complete application including:

- Application form
- A letter from your child describing why they would like to attend Earth Academy
- **For educators, counselors, or mentors:** Please provide a brief description of why you recommend this child to be a camper at Earth Academy Day Camp along with your name
- Verification of free or reduced lunch eligibility. You can request proof of free or reduced lunch through your child's school by calling the SBAC's Food Service Office at 352-955-7539, extension 1569. Ask that the letter be emailed to you and earthacademy@cityofgainesville.org

3) Register for camp starting 9am, March 7th online. Use your coupon to receive the awarded discount
