# How To MEASURE YOUR TREE 

TO DETERMINE WHETHER YOU WILL NEED A TREE REMOVAL PERMIT

## YOU WILL NEED:

- A measuring tape
- A calculator, or good algebraic skills


## STEP I: MEASURE THE CIRCUMFERENCE

 Using your measuring tape, measure around the trunk of the tree, in inches, at $41 / 2$ feet from the ground.
## STEP 2: DIVIDE BY 3.14

Once you have the circumference,
you now need to find the diameter. Dividing by Pi ( $\pi$ ), or 3.14 , will give you the diameter of the tree.

## STEP 3: KNOW YOUR REGULATIONS

On existing single-family homes, most trees will only become regulated at a diameter of $20^{\prime \prime}$. Reference our tree regulations infographics to learn more.
