
## HOW TO MEASURE YOUR TREE

TO DETERMINE WHETHER YOU WILL NEED A TREE REMOVAL PERMIT





### YOU WILL NEED:

- A measuring tape
- A calculator, or good algebraic skills

# STEP I: MEASURE THE CIRCUMFERENCE

Using your measuring tape, measure around the trunk of the tree, in inches, at 4 1/2 feet from the ground.





### STEP 2: DIVIDE BY 3.14

Once you have the circumference, you now need to find the diameter. Dividing by Pi ( $\pi$ ), or 3.14, will give you the diameter of the tree.

### STEP 3: KNOW YOUR REGULATIONS

On existing single-family homes, most trees will only become regulated at a diameter of 20". Reference our tree regulations infographics to learn more.
