## Alachua County to Host Spring Clean Out Day on Sat., April 15

The Alachua County Solid Waste & Resource Recovery Department, in collaboration with the Santa Fe College Teaching Zoo, invites residents to participate in the [Community Reuse & Recycle Day on Saturday, April 15, 2023](#). The event will be held from 9 AM to Noon at the Santa Fe College NW Campus, Construction Institute Parking Lot 9 on North Road, across from the gym. Volunteers will be onsite to direct cars in a one-way traffic pattern through the lot, allowing for safe and efficient offloading of materials.

- Housewares in usable condition

- Household Hazardous Waste (such as paint, chemicals, & old electronics for recycling)
