



HOW TO SAFELY DRIVE THROUGH A MID-BLOCK PEDESTRIAN SIGNAL



GO

*Drive the speed limit
and stay alert for
pedestrians.*



Prepare to STOP!



STOP

*Treat this light as a
normal red traffic signal.*

STOP!

*All vehicles must stop at
the flashing red light.*

*Vehicles shall proceed if there are
no pedestrians in the crosswalk.*



Florida Statute 316.075(1)(c) Steady Red Indication

1. Vehicular traffic facing a steady red signal shall stop before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection or, if none, then before entering the intersection and shall remain standing until a green indication is shown

Florida Statute 316.076(1)(a) Flashing Red (Stop Signal)

(a) When a red lens is illuminated with rapid intermittent flashes, drivers of vehicles shall stop at a clearly marked stop line, but if none, before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection, or if none, then at the point nearest the intersecting roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway before entering the intersection, and the right to proceed shall be subject to the rules applicable after making a stop at a stop sign



HOW TO USE A MID-BLOCK PEDESTRIAN SIGNAL



PUSH BUTTON

*Wait for the walk
signal before entering
crosswalk.*

CROSS

Watch for cars!



FINISH CROSSING

Do not enter crosswalk!

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
