

South Main St Crosswalk (600 block)

CITY COMMISSION DISTRICT I

The installation of a new crosswalk on the 600 block of South Main Street allows for safer crossing for pedestrians that travel between the commercial uses and available parking on either side of the street. This project was planned in coordination with adjacent businesses and was designed by Department of Transportation staff. The new crosswalk, associated curb ramps, and signage were then installed by the Public Works Department. The project ties to the City's *Strategic Plan Goal 3: A Great Place to Live and Experience* by promoting safety and accessibility to a diverse population.
