

NW 14th St / NW 15th St One-Way Pair (W University Ave to NW 5th Ave) CITY COMMISSION DISTRICT IV

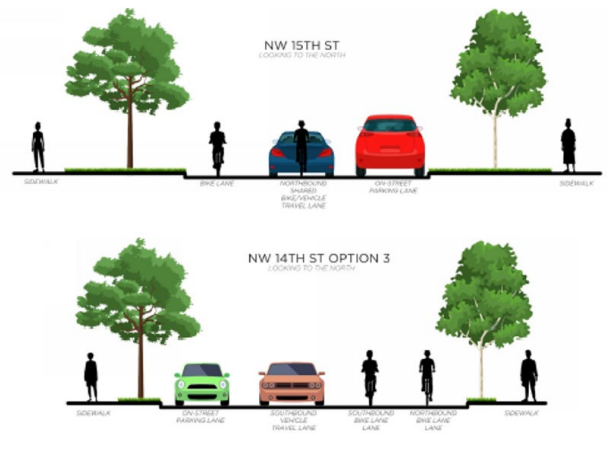
The one-way pair initiative was envisioned as part of the City's Vision Zero framework to decrease conflicts between vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians by implementing protected cycling facilities, decreasing crossing distances, reducing speed limits to 25 mph, and, eliminating turn movements at key intersections. The project was funded with a Capital Improvement Program allocation by the City Commission in Fiscal Year 2020. It involved extensive coordination with the University of Florida and the Florida Department of Transportation.

The project ties to the City's Strategic *Plan Goal 3: A Great Place to Live and Experience* by promoting safety and enhanced accessibility to a diverse population.
