

NW 2nd St Sidewalk (NW 16th Ave to Existing)

CITY COMMISSION DISTRICT IV

The NW 2nd Street sidewalk closed a gap in the sidewalk network enhancing access between residential and commercial areas. The project serves a residential community of older adults, with special accessibility needs. The project decreases the need for multiple road crossings to access the sidewalk on the opposite side of the street, addressed stormwater management issues, and added an enhanced crosswalk with pedestrian push buttons at the intersection of NW 16th Ave. It was funded as a Capital Improvement Program allocation by the City Commission in Fiscal Year 2018. The project ties to the City's Strategic *Plan Goal 3: A Great Place to Live and Experience* by promoting safety and accessibility to a diverse population.

Total Cost: \$198,533
