

## NW 8<sup>th</sup> St Sidewalk (NW 9<sup>th</sup> Ave to NW 10<sup>th</sup> Ave)

### CITY COMMISSION DISTRICT IV

The NW 8<sup>th</sup> Street sidewalk closed a gap in the sidewalk network enhancing access between residential and recreational areas, namely the City's new Oakview Park. The project serves a residential community of mixed ages and incomes, with relatively high levels of walking and biking. In addition to the sidewalk, the project added two standard driveways and made ADA upgrades to an existing pedestrian ramp. The project was funded through the City's TMPA fund in Fiscal Year 2021. The project ties to the City's Strategic Plan *Goal 1 (Equitable Community)*, *Goal 2 (Sustainable Community)*, and *Goal 3 (A Great Place to Live and Experience)*.
